1. **Writing Utensils**- students must bring a pencil and black pen to class everyday.

Writing Utensils - a pencil is preferred but students may use a pen. However, if they decide to use a pen they must *whiteout* all mistakes because neatness is a necessity. Therefore, WHITEOUT may be a supply you need. Also, please refrain from purchasing pens with fluorescent colored ink for use on assignments. The ink is hard to see, making your homework hard to grade, meaning you may have to redo it!

Paper - it doesn't matter if it is from a spiral notebook, loose-leaf, or note pad, but students must have paper *every day*.

Poster board - Approximately 5 pieces will be needed throughout the year for various projects and book reports. It is recommended that if you get the poster boards ahead of time, that you keep them at home until needed. The poster board, depending on the project may not have to be white.

Markers and Colored Pencils - will be needed for projects throughout the year. *Highlighters* are useful but not necessary.

Glue or Glue Sticks - will be needed for projects.
